TRANSIT FRUITS Marseille, founded in 1957, is a subsidiary of the COMPAGNIE FRUITIERE group.

As a Freight Forwarder, TRANSIT FRUITS carries goods under the EAGLE bill of lading on vessels operated by AEL (Africa Express Line, a subsidiary of the COMPAGNIE FRUITIERE group). TRANSIT FRUITS relies on its own network of EOLIS agents or representatives in all affected ports in Europe and West Africa.

AEL operates a fleet of 10 specialized vessels, all equipped with controlled atmosphere and differentiated temperature regulation systems.

These 10 vessels are deployed on two direct, fast, weekly and fixed-day services.

Containerized shipping

- A fleet of over 2,800 40'REEFER HC containers and a fleet of 20'DRY and 40'DRY HC containers of over 1,500 TEU.
- Each 40'Reefer container can be used unplugged (NOR: Non Operating Reefer) for stuffing and transporting dry general cargo.
- A fleet of 40'Flat Racks completes our equipment offer

Conventional and roll-on/roll-off shipping

10 multi-purpose vessels equipped with 4 holds, 4 warehouses, 4 on-board cranes and a large deck, are suitable for transporting all types of temperature-controlled and non-temperature-controlled goods:

- ONIONS AND POTATOES PALLETS: In holds equipped with differentiated temperature control systems.
- CONVENTIONAL: Wooden bundles, pallets, crates, drums, metal plates, boats, etc.
- ROLLING: Cars, trucks, public works and agricultural machinery, etc.
